WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF SINGLE VEHICLE COLLISION INVOLVING A MOTORCYCLE IN THE AREA OF BERRY ROAD AND IOWA STREET ON 11/9. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS FOUND A SINGLE INDIVIDUAL WITH A HEAD WOUND. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT THE DRIVER OF THE MOTORCYCLE WAS INTOXICATED AND LOST CONTROL OF THE MOTORCYCLE JUST BEFORE THE CRASH OCCURRED. THE DRIVER WAS TAKEN TO AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A BURGLARY IN THE 100 BLOCK OF E. HADDOCK STREET ON 11/11. THE REPORTING PARTY ADVISED THE SUSPECT, A NEIGHBOR, BROKE INTO THE RESIDENCE AND TOOK SEVERAL ITEMS. OFFICERS ATTEMPTED TO CONTACT THE SUSPECT WHO FLED IN A VEHICLE. THE SUSPECT DROVE RECKLESSLY AT HIGH SPEEDS AND RAMMED MULTIPLE VEHICLES BEFORE OFFICERS DISABLED THE VEHICLE. THE SUSPECT WAS TAKEN TO CCDC FOR VIOLATING PAROLE, ELUDING, ASSAULT WITH A DANGEROUS WEAPON, POSSESSION OF A FIREARM AFTER CONVICTION, AND BURGLARY.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SINGLE VEHICLE FATALITY COLLISION IN THE 11000 BLOCK OF E. ETOWAH ROAD ON 11/12. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THE INDIVIDUAL SUSTAINED A FATAL MEDICAL EVENT WHILE DRIVING WHICH RESULTED IN THE COLLISION.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A COLLISION NEAR CENTRAL PKWY AND 12TH AVE NE ON 11/12. ONE OF THE DRIVERS HAD A SIGNIFICANT HEAD INJURY AND WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE CIRT TEAM.
- PATROL RESPONDED TO A COLLISION NEAR ROBINSON ST. AND CANTERBURY AVE ON 11/13. INITIAL INFORMATION INDICATES THAT A MOTORCYCLIST WAS DRIVING RECKLESSLY PRIOR TO THE COLLISION AND WAS STRUCK BY AN SUV. THE MOTORCYCLIST SUSTAINED SIGNIFICANT INJURIES AND WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL WHERE THEY DIED FROM INJURIES SUSTAINED. THE COLLISION IS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE CIRT TEAM.
