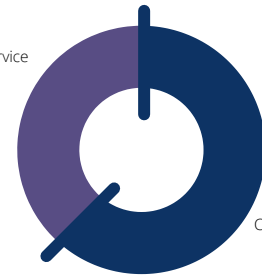

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SHOOTING IN THE 14000 BLOCK OF E IMHOFF RD ON 11/18. UPON ARRIVAL, OFFICERS LOCATED A MALE WITH A GUNSHOT WOUND. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATED TWO INDIVIDUALS PLANNED TO ROB THE VICTIM. DURING THE ROBBERY, SHOTS WERE FIRED, STRIKING THE VICTIM IN THE HEAD. OFFICERS FOUND ONE OF THE SUSPECTS HIDING IN A NEARBY FIELD. OFFICERS ARRESTED THE TWO SUSPECTS AND BOOKED THEM INTO CCDC ON COMPLAINTS OF ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON AND CONJOINT ROBBERY.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A DISTURBANCE IN THE 3000 BLK OF CORDOVA COURT ON 11/22. THE DOMESTIC DISTURBANCE HAD RESULTED TO INJURIES TO TWO VICTIMS WHO WERE ABLE TO EXIT THE RESIDENCE. THE SUSPECT HAD BARRICADED HIMSELF WITHIN THE RESIDENCE WITH POSSIBLE ACCESS TO A FIREARM. AFTER ATTEMPTS BY A SWAT NEGOTIATOR, OFFICERS ENTERED THE RESIDENCE AND UTILIZED A TASER TO ASSIST WITH PLACING THE SUSPECT INTO CUSTODY. THE SUSPECT WAS ARRESTED AND TRANSPORTED TO CCDC ON MULTIPLE COMPLAINTS RELATING TO DOMESTIC ABUSE.
- OFFICERS WORKING THE AREA OF CAMPUS CORNER ON 11/23 HEARD MULTIPLE GUNSHOT SHOTS AND SAW PEOPLE RUNNING FROM A PARKING LOT IN THE AREA. AFTER AN INITIAL ASSESSMENT, OFFICERS LOCATED A SUSPECT IN A VEHICLE NEARBY WITH 3 OTHER SUBJECTS. WITNESSES IDENTIFIED THE DRIVER AS THE ONE WHO HAD FIRED THE GUN. OFFICERS FOUND A GUN AND SHELL CASINGS IN THE VEHICLE. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED. THE SUSPECT WAS ARRESTED ON VARIOUS CHARGES AND TAKEN TO CCDC.
- DURING THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 16-29, NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 83 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND REUNITED 14 WITH THEIR OWNERS. THEY ALSO TOOK IN 83 NEW ANIMALS DURING THIS TIME. NAW CURRENTLY HAS 120 ANIMALS IN OUR CARE, WITH 42 PLACED IN FOSTER HOMES.
