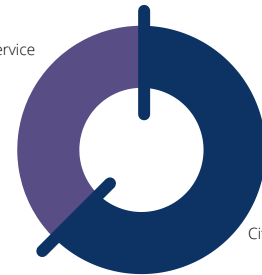

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A ROBBERY WITH A KNIFE IN THE 2200 BLK OF W. MAIN ST. ON 12/1. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THE SUSPECT ASSAULTED AN EMPLOYEE BEFORE LEAVING THE AREA. UPON RESPONSE AND A SEARCH OF THE AREA, OFFICERS WERE UNABLE TO LOCATE THE SUSPECT OR SUSPECT VEHICLE. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION. THE VICTIM SUSTAINED MINOR INJURIES DURING THE INCIDENT.
