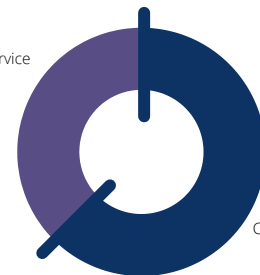

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN OFFICER-INVOLVED COLLISION ON STATE HIGHWAY 9 JUST WEST OF 108<sup>TH</sup> AVE SE ON 12/11. THE OFFICER WAS STRUCK WHILE OUTSIDE OF HIS PATROL VEHICLE RESPONDING TO A PRIOR INCIDENT.

SGT. HACKBARTH WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL. HE REMAINS IN CRITICAL BUT STABLE CONDITION. OVER THE COURSE OF THE LAST WEEK, SGT. HACKBARTH HAS UNDERGONE TWO SURGERIES. HE CONTINUES TO RECEIVE CARE AND RECOVER IN THE INTENSIVE CARE UNIT.
