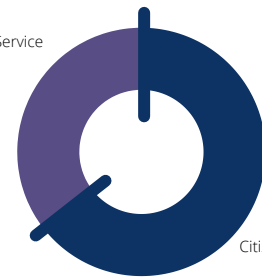

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN ACCIDENTAL SHOOTING IN THE 1100 BLOCK OF BRANDYWINE LN ON 12/31. INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT ONE INDIVIDUAL ACCIDENTALLY DISCHARGED THEIR FIREARM STRIKING BOTH THEMSELVES AND ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL NEXT TO THEM. BOTH INDIVIDUALS WERE TRANSPORTED TO A HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT FOR NON-LIFE-THREATENING INJURIES.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A SHOOTING IN THE 100 BLOCK OF W. VIDA WAY ON 1/3. THE CALLER REPORTED A LOUD PARTY AT THIS LOCATION AND THAT THEY HEARD AT LEAST ONE GUNSHOT. INDIVIDUALS WERE SEEN RUNNING AWAY FROM THIS LOCATION AS OFFICERS ARRIVED. THE PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION FOUND THAT THE RESIDENCE WAS ABANDONED AND PEOPLE WERE USING IT AS A PARTY HOUSE. NO VICTIMS OR SUSPECTS WERE LOCATED OR IDENTIFIED.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 23 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 9 REUNITED WITH THEIR OWNERS. NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE ALSO TOOK IN 38 NEW ANIMALS DURING THIS PERIOD.
