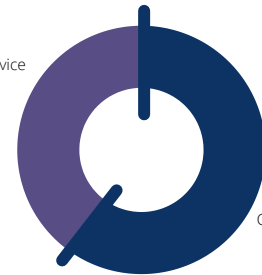

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A DISTURBANCE THE 1500 BLOCK OF E. ROBINSON ON 1/7. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS LOCATED AN INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS THREATENING ANOTHER WITH A HATCHET. BOTH WERE INTOXICATED. THE SUSPECT WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT INCIDENT AND BOOKED INTO CCDC ON A COMPLAINT OF THREATS WITH A DEADLY WEAPON. NO ONE WAS INJURED DURING THE INCIDENT.
- OFFICERS ASSISTED A METRO AGENCY ON SERVING AN ARREST WARRANT RELATED TO A CASE INVOLVING A BURGLARY, STOLEN VEHICLE, AND POSSESSION OF CDS. OFFICERS LOCATED THE SUSPECT DRIVING IN THE AREA OF ROCK CREEK RD ON 1/7. THE SUSPECT WAS ARRESTED WITHOUT INCIDENT. A SEARCH OF THE VEHICLE LOCATED AGGREGATED TRAFFICKING AMOUNTS OF FENTANYL PILLS AND ADDITIONAL DRUG PARAPHERNALIA. THE SUSPECT WAS BOOKED IN TO CCDC ON MULTIPLE CHARGES.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 38 ANIMALS ADOPTED AND 6 REUNITED WITH THEIR OWNERS THIS WEEK. THEY ALSO TOOK IN 44 NEW ANIMALS TO THE FACILITY. NAW CURRENTLY HAS 111 ANIMALS THEIR OUR CARE WITH 33 IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
