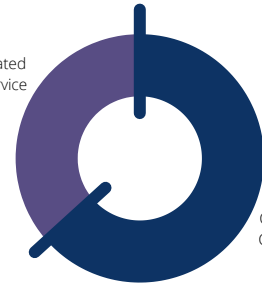

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF SHOTS FIRED IN THE 3400 BLK OF PORTER AVE ON 1/27. INITIAL REPORTS WERE THAT A MALE HAD FIRED MULTIPLE SHOTS BEFORE LEAVING THE AREA IN A VEHICLE. OFFICERS LOCATED THE VEHICLE AND THE SUSPECT NEARBY. HE WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AND THE FIREARM RECOVERED WITHOUT INCIDENT. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT THE MALE FIRED MULTIPLE SHOTS AT THE GROUND IN PROTEST OF BEING REFUSED SERVICE AT THE BAR BEFORE DRIVING AWAY AND FIRING ADDITIONAL SHOTS FROM HIS VEHICLE WHILE AT THE INTERSECTION OF PORTER AND TECUMSEH RD. NO ONE WAS INJURED, AND NO STRUCTURES WERE HIT. THE SUSPECT WAS ARRESTED ON COMPLAINTS OF DUI, RECKLESS DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM, AND POSSESSION OF A FIREARM WHEN INTOXICATED.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SHOOTING IN THE 2100 BLK OF W. BROOKS ON 1/28. UPON ARRIVAL, OFFICERS LOCATED BULLET HOLES IN A DOOR AND WINDOW, AND FOUND A VICTIM WAS LYING ON A COUCH INSIDE. INITIAL INFORMATION REVEALED THAT THE SUSPECT AND VICTIM KNEW EACH OTHER, BUT THE VICTIM DID NOT KNOW WHY THE SUSPECT FIRED THE SHOTS INTO THE RESIDENCE. OFFICERS LOCATED THE SUSPECT AND THE FIREARM. THE VICTIM WAS TAKEN TO AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT OF NON-LIFE-THREATENING INJURIES. THE SUSPECT WAS BOOKED INTO CCDC.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE ADOPTED OUT 26 ANIMALS, REUNITED 6 WITH THEIR OWNERS, AND TRANSFERRED 8 TO RESCUES THIS WEEK. NAW ALSO TOOK IN 42 NEW ANIMALS. THEY CURRENTLY HAVE 131 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 27 IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
