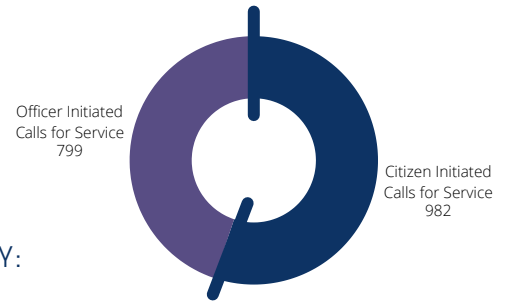

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A BURGLARY IN PROGRESS IN THE 2300 BLK OF ASHWOOD LANE ON 2/5. THE SUSPECT LEFT THE RESIDENCE PRIOR TO OFFICERS ARRIVING, HOWEVER THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION CONFIRMED THAT THE SUSPECT HAD ENTERED THE HOME WHILE THE RESIDENTS WERE PRESENT. OFFICERS, WITH THE HELP OF A DRONE, LOCATED THE SUSPECT NEARBY AND ARRESTED HIM FOR BREAKING AND ENTERING.
- THE PAGE UNIT COMPLETED AN UNDER 21 ALCOHOL OPERATION ON 2/4. THE UNIT CONTACTED 17 BUSINESSES IN AN ATTEMPT TO PURCHASE ALCOHOL PRODUCTS WITH THE HELP OF AN 18-YEAR-OLD VOLUNTEER. OF THE 17 STORES CONTACTED, ONE STORE SOLD TO THE UNDERAGE VOLUNTEER. A DOCKET FOR FURNISHING ALCOHOL PRODUCTS TO THOSE UNDER 21 WAS ISSUED TO THE BUSINESS.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE COORDINATED ADOPTION OF 35 ANIMALS AND REUNITED 7 WITH THEIR OWNERS THIS WEEK. THE CENTER ALSO TOOK IN 44 NEW ANIMALS. NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 132 ANIMALS IN OUR CARE WITH 33 PLACED IN FOSTER HOMES.
