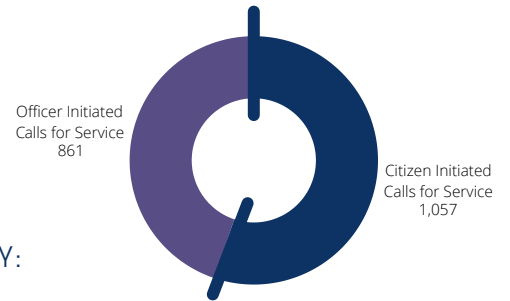

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO AN INJURY COLLISION INVOLVING TWO VEHICLES AT THE INTERSECTION OF SH-9 AND 84<sup>TH</sup> AVE SE ON 2/11. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THE SEDAN WAS TRAVELING SB ON 84<sup>TH</sup> AVE. AS THE SEDAN ENTERED THE INTERSECTION, AN SUV TRAVELING WB ON SH-9 COLLIDED WITH THE SEDAN. TWO INDIVIDUALS DIED AT THE SCENE. THE COLLISION IS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE NPD/OUPD CIRT TEAM.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO AN INJURY COLLISION IN THE 1500 BLK OF 24<sup>TH</sup> AVE NE ON 2/14. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS LOCATED A MOTORCYCLE WITH TWO RIDERS THAT HAD CRASHED. ONE WAS DECLARED DECEASED AT THE SCENE. THE OTHER WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL. THE COLLISION IS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE NPD/OUPD CIRT TEAM.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SUBJECT WALKING AROUND FIRING A GUN IN THE AREA OF MAIN ST AND PORTER AVE IN THE EARLY MORNING HOURS OF 2/14. OFFICERS HEARD ADDITIONAL GUNSHOTS UPON ARRIVING THE AREA. THEY WERE ABLE TO QUICKLY LOCATE THE INDIVIDUAL RESPONSIBLE NEARBY AND HE WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT INCIDENT AND THE FIREARM RECOVERED. THE SUSPECT WAS BOOKED INTO CCDC ON MULTIPLE CHARGES RELATED TO THE INCIDENT. NO INJURIES OR PROPERTY DAMAGE WAS LOCATED OR REPORTED.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A FATALITY COLLISION INVOLVING A TRAIN AND PEDESTRIAN AT THE TECUMSEH RD RAILROAD CROSSING ON 2/14. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS LOCATED ON ADULT FEMALE DECEASED NEAR THE TRACKS. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THE FEMALE WALKED ONTO THE TRACKS AND WAS STRUCK BY A TRAIN TRAVELING SOUTHBOUND. COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE NPD/OUPD CIRT TEAM.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 39 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 3 TRANSFERRED TO RESCUES, AND 6 REUNITED WITH THEIR OWNERS THIS WEEK. THE FACILITY ALSO TOOK IN 41 NEW ANIMALS.
