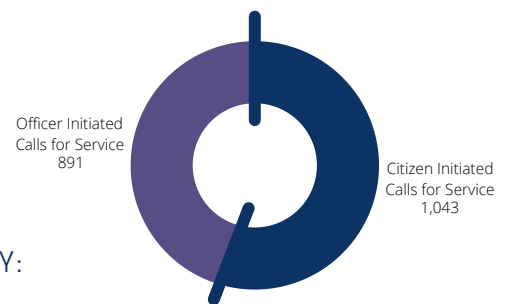

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO AN INJURY COLLISION ON THE I-35 OFF-RAMP AT INDIAN HILLS RD ON 2/19. INITIAL REPORTS INDICATED THAT THE COLLISION INVOLVED A VEHICLE AND A MOTORCYCLE WITH ONE OF THEM ON FIRE FOLLOWING THE COLLISION. EMERGENCY PERSONNEL LOCATED THE MOTORCYCLIST WHO WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR INJURIES SUSTAINED DURING THE COLLISION. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- ON 02/20 AN OFFICER OBSERVED A VEHICLE DRIVING VERY ERRATICALLY. THE OFFICER INITIATED A TRAFFIC STOP, BUT THE VEHICLE CONTINUED. THE OFFICER ATTEMPTED AN TACTICAL VEHICLE INTERVENTION, BUT WERE UNSUCCESSFUL. THE DRIVER EVENTUALLY CRASHED NEAR 24TH AVE NW AND MAIN ST. THE DRIVER WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY FOR SEVERAL TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS, FELONY ELUDING, AND OBSTRUCTION.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF SHOTS HEARD IN THE 400 BLK OF 24TH AVE NW ON 2/21. OFFICERS CHECKED THE AREA AND FOUND SEVERAL SHELL CASINGS IN THE PARKING LOT. NO DAMAGE OR REPORTS OF INJURIES WERE LOCATED. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- NPD KICKED OFF ITS NEXT CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY ON 2/19. PARTICIPANTS GOT TO MEET ONE ANOTHER AND GAIN AN OVERVIEW OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT ON NIGHT ONE. WE LOOK FORWARD TO PARTNERING WITH OUR CPAAN VOLUNTEERS ON ANOTHER CLASS!
- OFFICERS AND OUR PUBLIC SAFETY CADETS JOINED THE COMMUNITY TO MAKE A SPLASH FOR SPECIAL OLYMPICS DURING THE SPECIAL OLYMPICS OKLAHOMA POLAR PLUNGE EVENT ON 2/21.
