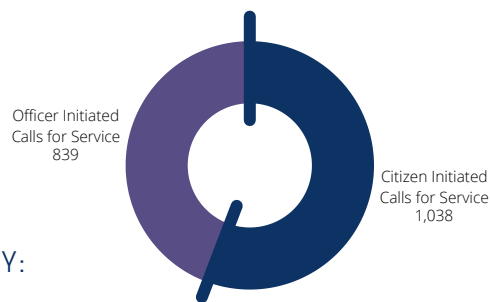

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO AN INJURY COLLISION INVOLVING A PEDESTRIAN IN THE AREA OF PORTER AVE AND FRANK ST ON 3/4. THE PEDESTRIAN WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL IN CRITICAL CONDITION. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATED THE PEDESTRIAN WAS CROSSING PORTER AVE WHEN THEY WERE STRUCK BY A VEHICLE TRAVELING SOUTHBOUND. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE NPD/OU PD CIRT TEAM.
- OFFICERS OBSERVED A VEHICLE DRIVING RECKLESSLY ON FLOOD AVE NEAR JAMES GARNER AVE ON 3/7. THE VEHICLE WAS SWERVING AND DRIVING INTO ONCOMING TRAFFIC. AN OFFICER ATTEMPTED A TRAFFIC STOP, BUT THE DRIVER CONTINUED TO DRIVE RECKLESSLY. THE OFFICER COMPLETED A TACTICAL VEHICLE INTERVENTION WHICH BROUGHT THE VEHICLE TO A STOP. NEITHER THE JUVENILE DRIVER NOR THE ADULT OCCUPANT OF THE VEHICLE SHOWED SIGNS OF INTOXICATION WHEN CONTACTED. THE DRIVER WAS ARRESTED FOR ATTEMPTING TO ELUDE A POLICE OFFICER.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE ADOPTED 32 ANIMALS, REUNITED 13 WITH THEIR OWNERS, AND TRANSFERRED 4 TO OTHER RESCUES THIS WEEK. THE CENTER ALSO TOOK IN 38 NEW ANIMALS DURING THIS TIME. NAW CURRENTLY HAS 97 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 27 IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
