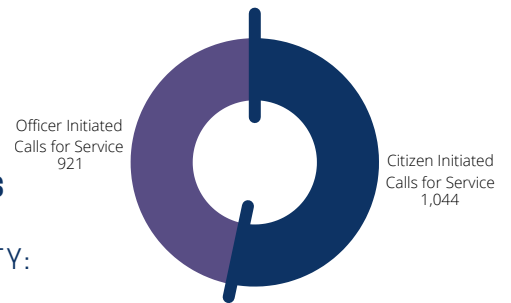

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A STABBING IN THE 200 BLOCK OF REED AVE ON 3/10. UPON ARRIVAL, A MALE SUBJECT WAS FOUND LYING ON THE GROUND WITH SEVERAL STAB WOUNDS. OFFICERS LOCATED THE SUSPECT NEARBY. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL IN STABLE CONDITION. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SINGLE VEHICLE COLLISION IN THE ROUNDABOUT AT FLOOD AND JAMES GARNER AVE ON 3/10. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT A MOTORCYCLE LOST CONTROL AND COLLIDED WITH A LIGHT POLE. THE DRIVER WAS TRANSPORTED AND LATER DIED FROM INJURIES SUSTAINED DURING THE COLLISION. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE CIRT TEAM.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A VEHICLE WHO DROVE INTO A RESIDENCE IN THE 2100 BLOCK OF BARTON STREET ON 3/11. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS LOCATED THE VEHICLE WHO HAD LEFT THE SCENE AT ANOTHER RESIDENCE DOWN THE STREET. THE DRIVER WAS ARRESTED FOR AGGRAVATED DUI. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED.
- THE PACE UNIT CONDUCTED AN UNDER 21 TOBACCO/VAPE OPERATION ON 3/11. 18 STORES WERE CONTACTED DURING THE OPERATION AND TWO SOLD TO THE MINOR VOLUNTEER. BOTH WERE ISSUED CITATIONS.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE ADOPTED 29 ANIMALS, REUNITED 10 WITH THEIR OWNERS, AND TRANSFERRED 1 TO A RESCUE. THE FACILITY ALSO TOOK IN 43 NEW ANIMALS DURING THIS WEEK. NAW CURRENTLY HAS 95 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 32 IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
