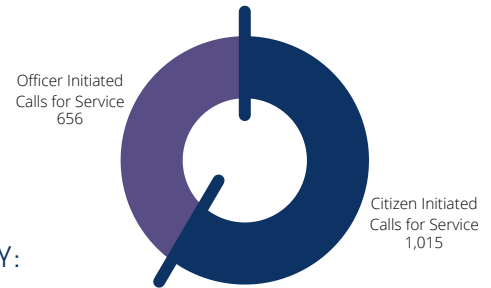

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN INJURY COLLISION AT ALAMEDA AND 60TH AVE ON 3/23. TWO VEHICLES WERE INVOLVED IN THE COLLISION. ONE INDIVIDUAL WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL IN CRITICAL CONDITION. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE NPD/OUPD CIRT TEAM.
- NPD SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS ARRESTED A 16YO MALE AT NORMAN NORTH HIGH SCHOOL FOR A COMPLAINT OF POSSESSION OF A FIREARM ON SCHOOL PROPERTY ON 3/23. SROS LOCATED THE FIREARM DURING THE INVESTIGATION INTO A VERBAL THREAT MADE TOWARD ANOTHER STUDENT. THE MALE WAS TRANSPORTED TO A JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITY.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SINGLE VEHICLE FATALITY COLLISION INVOLVING A MOTORCYCLE NEAR 60TH AVE SE AND SH-9 ON 3/24. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT THE DRIVER WAS TRAVELING NORTHBOUND ON 60TH AVE SE WHEN THEY LOST CONTROL AND COLLIDED WITH A GUARDRAIL. THE DRIVER WAS PRONOUNCED DECEASED AT THE SCENE. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE CIRT TEAM.
- OFFICERS WERE INVOLVED IN AN INJURY COLLISION NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF CLASSEN BLVD AND LINDSEY ST ON 3/24. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT TWO NPD OFFICERS WERE TRAVELING SB ON CLASSEN BLVD RESPONDING TO A REPORT OF A FATALITY COLLISION WHEN ANOTHER VEHICLE TURNED IN FRONT OF THE SECOND OFFICER'S VEHICLE. THE OFFICER AND THE DRIVER OF THE OTHER VEHICLE WERE TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL. BOTH WERE LATER RELEASED. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE CIRT TEAM.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORTED COLLISION IN THE AREA OF ROCK CREEK RD AND 156TH AVE NE. INITIAL REPORTS WERE THAT A SUBJECT WAS LYING IN THE ROAD NEXT TO A MOTORCYCLE. FIRST RESPONDERS PROVIDED LIFE-SAVING MEASURES AT THE SCENE AND THEN THE INDIVIDUAL WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE CIRT TEAM.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN INDIVIDUAL STABBED IN THE 800 BLOCK OF CHAUTAUQUA AVE ON 3/27. A LARGE OUTDOOR CONCERT WAS OCCURRING AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT. OFFICERS CONTACTED A MALE WITH A SUPERFICIAL CUT. THE INDIVIDUAL WAS TREATED AT THE SCENE AND DID NOT SEEK TO PURSUE CHARGES.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE ADOPTED OUT 20 ANIMALS, REUNITED 4 WITH THEIR OWNERS, AND TRANSFERRED 1 TO A RESCUE THIS WEEK. NAW ALSO TOOK IN 47 ANIMALS. THEY CURRENTLY HAVE 127 ANIMALS IN OUR CARE WITH 26 OF THOSE IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
