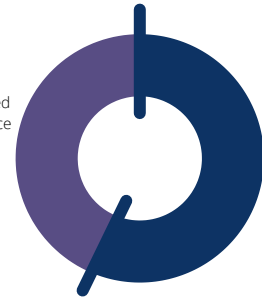

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF DISTURBANCE INVOLVING A WEAPON INSIDE A BUSINESS IN THE 1400 BLK OF 24<sup>TH</sup> AVE NW ON 3/29. THE INITIAL REPORT WAS THAT A MALE HAD MADE A THREAT AND HAD A GUN. ONCE ON SCENE, OFFICERS LOCATED THE ALLEGED SUSPECT MATCHING THE DESCRIPTION NEAR THE ENTRANCE TO THE STORE. THE ALLEGED SUSPECT WAS DETAINED WITHOUT INCIDENT. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT A VERBAL ALTERCATION OCCURRED BETWEEN THE ALLEGED SUSPECT AND SEVERAL OTHER INDIVIDUALS INSIDE THE STORE. DURING THE DISTURBANCE THERE WERE INDICATIONS IT WAS TURNING PHYSICAL, SO THE ALLEGED SUSPECT MADE THE OTHER INDIVIDUALS AWARE OF A GUN IN HIS WAISTBAND THAT HE WOULD UTILIZE IN SELF-DEFENSE. THE ALLEGED SUSPECT WAS RELEASED AFTER BEING DETAINED AT THE SCENE DUE TO THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION WITH ALL INVOLVED PARTIES AND REVIEWS OF ASSOCIATED VIDEO FOOTAGE. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO AN INJURY COLLISION IN THE 1000 BLK OF ALAMEDA ON 4/2. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES A VEHICLE STRUCK A PEDESTRIAN IN THE ROADWAY. THE PEDESTRIAN WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE NPD/OUVD CIRT TEAM.
- NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 33 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 7 REUNITED WITH THEIR OWNERS, AND 1 TRANSFERRED OUT TO A RESCUE THIS WEEK. THE FACILITY ALSO TOOK IN 39 NEW ANIMALS. THERE ARE CURRENTLY 126 ANIMALS IN THE CARE OF NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE WITH 39 IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
