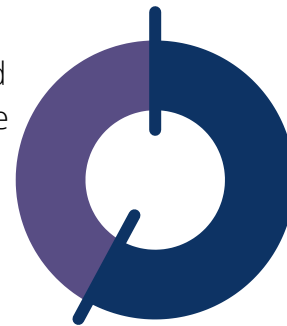

WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A WELFARE CHECK IN THE AREA OF ELM AVE AND BROOKS ST ON 5/3. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT AN INDIVIDUAL INVOLVED IN A FIGHT WITH ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL WAS STRUCK BY A VEHICLE TRAVELING SOUTHBOUND ON ELM. THE INDIVIDUALS HAD FALLEN INTO THE STREET WHILE FIGHTING, AND ONE STRUCK THE BACKEND OF THE TRUCK. THE INJURIES WERE MINOR AND THE INDIVIDUAL WAS SUBSEQUENTLY ARRESTED FOR PUBLIC INTOXICATION.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN INJURY COLLISION AT THE INTERSECTION OF CEDAR LANE RD AND CLASSEN BLVD ON 5/8. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES A DEPUTY WITH THE CLEVELAND COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE WAS TRAVELING SOUTHBOUND ON CLASSEN BLVD. RESPONDING TO ANOTHER INCIDENT WHEN THEY COLLIDED WITH A VEHICLE TRAVELING WESTBOUND ON CEDAR LANE RD. IN THE INTERSECTION. THE CCSO DEPUTY WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR INJURIES SUSTAINED DURING THE COLLISION. THE DEPUTY WAS LATER RELEASED AFTER RECEIVING TREATMENT. THE DRIVER OF THE OTHER VEHICLE, A 32-YEAR-OLD FEMALE, SUSTAINED SIGNIFICANT INJURIES IN THE COLLISION AND WAS LATER PRONOUNCED DECEASED AT THE SCENE. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE NPD CIRT TEAM.
- 18 COMMUNITY MEMBERS GRADUATED FROM THE 23RD CLASS OF THE NORMAN CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY ON 5/7. THE 11-WEEK CLASS OFFERS CITIZENS INSIGHT INTO HOW POLICE OFFICERS PERFORM THEIR DUTIES AND HOW THE DEPARTMENT SERVES THE COMMUNITY.
